III. Old Generation

a. Numbering (1-4)

member of adult males, tribe distribution, number of Levite males, Levite duties

b. Instructing (5-10)

(5) lepers, (6) nazirites, (7) free will offerings of leaders, (8) consecration of Levites, (9) passover and pillar were fellowship and guidance, (10) trumpets (guidance for the ear) as a rallying call; signal for advance; call in time of war; memorial before God

III. Old Generation (cont.)

a. Journey (10-14)

Sinai to Kadesh

Spies and rebellion due to lack of faith; Joshua 2:8-11
complaining (10-14); Moses experiences murmuring
by family

IV. Wilderness (14:33 – pasture)

- a. not abandoned by God
- b. no circumcision (Joshua 5:4-8)
- c. law disobeyed (Ezekiel 20:10-26); probably no passover enacted due to the hurt of that sacrifice
- d. Korah rebellion (16:8-11)
- e. Red heifer and rebellion against Aaron (16:19, 19:1-3)
- f. End of this section has death of Miriam, sin of Moses, death of Aaron, none can lead us to our rest except Joshua (Jesus in Hebrew)
