II Chronicles

- A. Judah is center of II Chronicles, no northern kingdom
- B. Solomon- account of his reign is shorter yet
 - i. 2:1, 3:1, 5:1, 6:10-11
 - ii. 6 of 9 chapters reference the temple

II Chronicles

- C. Asa, Jehoshaphat, Joash, Hezekiah, Josiah – religious reforms drive the narrative In book of Chronicles where the rule of the kings drives the book of Kings- 3 verses refer to Hezekiah's reforms in Kings, In Chronicles- 3 chapters refer to Hezekiah's reforms
- i. Asa- II Chronicles 14:1-4, 15:8
 - ii. Jehoshaphat- II Chronicles 17:3-6, 20:8-9
 - iii. Joash- II Chronicles 24:4 -Not perfect
 - iv. Hezekiah- II Chronicles 29:1-5
 - v. Josiah- II Chronicles 34:1-2, 8

I & II Kings- Throne

I & II Chronicles – Temple

- Post exile- no throne
- Throne is to create and maintain the temple, not vice versa
- God's sovereignty overwhelms- I Samuel 8
- Here is the reason for Matthew 27:20, Acts 1:6

David- I Chronicles 11:40

Uzzah- I Chronicles 13:9-10
