⇒ Please <u>DO NOT</u> drop off this form and registration fee at the nursery counter at any time or in the drop box by the Weekday office. Please, hand it and your registration fee personally to the Weekday director or her assistant ONLY.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Child must be age 3 or 4 by September 1, 2018.
- <u>Child must be toilet trained</u> by the first day of class on September 5, 2018.
 - Keep in mind if a child has more than one accident at school during a week or four accidents during one month, they are not considered potty trained and may be asked to leave the program.
- The non-refundable \$125 registration fee must be paid for a spot for your child to be held.
- The family MUST NOT have an outstanding balance in MDO or Weekday School .
- By Monday, <u>August 6, 2018</u>, all required forms <u>MUST</u> be completed and submitted to the Weekday office staff to hold your spot.
 - Current immunization records are required before your child can attend AND if your child is 4 years old, we MUST have vision and hearing test results on file before your child can attend.
 - A statement from your child's doctor stating your child is cleared to participate in our program (or daycare). This is a state requirement, and most doctors have a standard health statement they can sign and give you to submit to Weekday to meet state requirements.


